

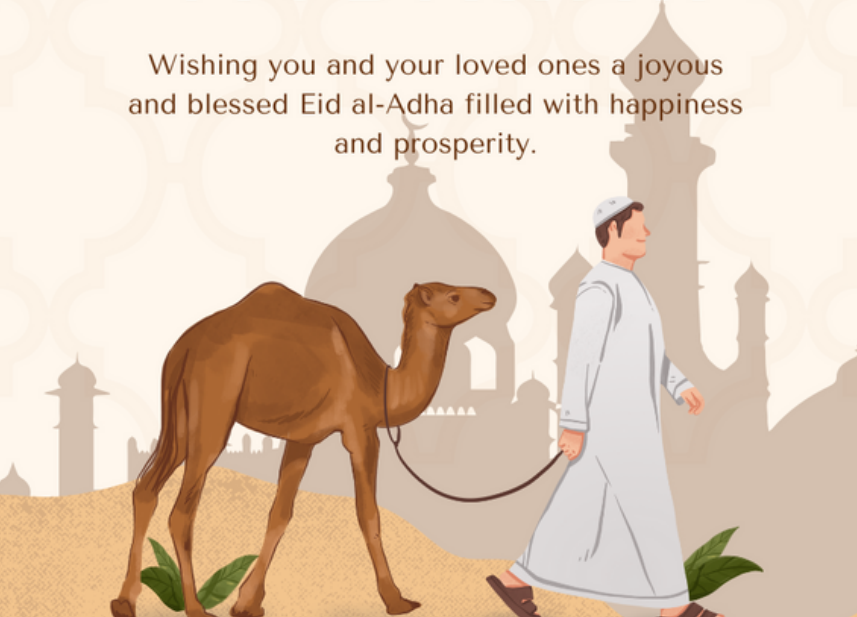

Dr. Sohail Ansari 1971, President of the Habibian Alumni Association UK Chapter, hosted a lunch in London at the Selfridges Restaurant on Friday June 13, to honor Mr. Saeed Allawala, the President of the HPSAA. Alumni based in London were invited to attend. During the event, it was decided to restructure the UK chapter, appointing Mr. Mohsin Hafeez (Batch 1974), as President and Mr. Aziz Bilgrami (Batch 1980), as General Secretary. The objectives of the association were discussed, and special emphasis was given to a financial assistance plan for Habibians worldwide but especially living in the UK. Additionally, it was agreed to hold a UK convention in October or November 2025. Atif Aslam is anticipated to visit London soon for a fundraising concert for the NGO The Health Foundation. Special ticket prices would be offered to the music lover of Habibian attendees.
